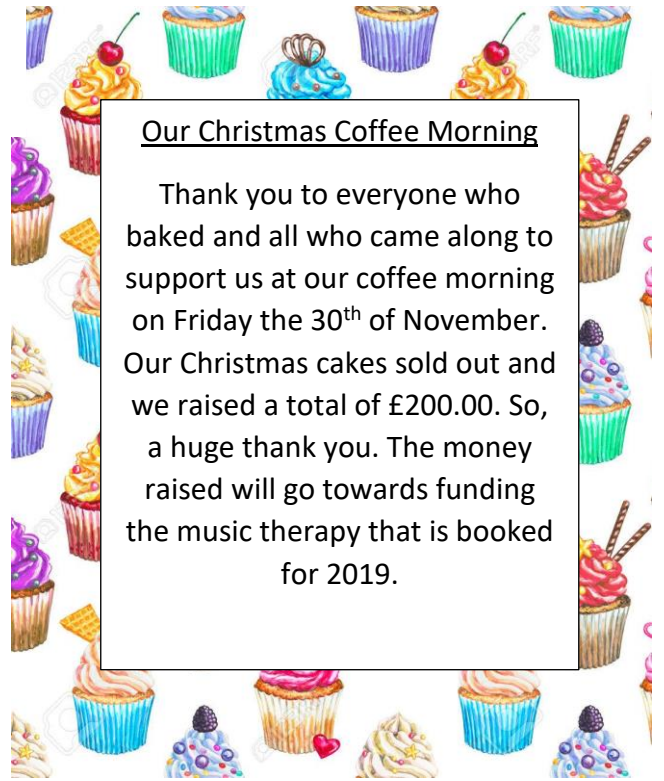


Hope church visited with Christmas carols on an afternoon on Friday the 14th of December was spent with Hope church who came along to sing Christmas carols.
